Due to the spread of infection of COVID-19, Japan declared a nationwide state of emergency on April 16, and with that, Hokkaido Government also declared a state of emergency.

In light of this circumstance, in order to ensure students' health and safety, Hokkaido University has established the "Hokkaido University's Business Continuity Plan to prevent the spread of infection of COVID-19 (BCP)", and we declared "Level 3 (High)" on April 20.
